Present: Mayor Brenda Moore, Attorney Mark Hall, Councilwoman Linda Cook, Councilwoman Danielle Wood, Councilwoman Ashley Stewart, Councilwoman Evelyn Saldana, Councilwoman Kim Richards, Councilman Toby Clark, Chief of Police James Sherrard, and City Clerk Debbie Batliner.

Mayor Moore called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

On the agenda was the second reading of Ordinance 288 Series 2021. Discussions were held regarding the language that was in the ordinance repealing and replacing the entire ordinance. Attorney Hall stated to be valid, the new Ordinance would need to have all of the language of the previous ordinance along with the amendment to replace the section that was drafted to mirror J-town's ordinance. Council discussed changing ordinance and having first reading of newly drafted ordinance tonight and have second reading of the new ordinance on Monday March 8, 2021. Ordinance was sponsored by Councilwoman Wood.

City of West Buechel held first reading of Ordinance 288 Series 2021.

Discussions were held regarding the Council obtaining a listing of all city employees, title and compensation. Attorney Hall stated that legally per Open Records Law, that everyone is entitled to this information. Councilwoman Wood stated that JD Cheney, Attorney with KLC, stated that all council members should have the City's pay and compensation plan. Councilwoman Wood motioned for the City Council members to get a copy of the pay and compensation plan. Councilwoman Saldana second. The vote was unanimous. Councilwoman Richards stated that was not what she wanted. A motion was made by Councilwoman Richards to get a list of employees, position and salary. Motion dies for lack of second.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Wood and second by Councilwoman Stewart to adjourn. The meeting concluded at approximately 7:55 PM. Motion carries with unanimous vote.
