Mayor Moore called the meeting to order at 7:04 pm.

A motion to approve the minutes of February 6, 2020 was made by Councilwoman Stewart and seconded by Councilman Campbell. Motion carries with unanimous vote.

Department Reports:

Community Development Community Center report was suspended.

Police Department: Police Reports were included in packet.

Code Enforcement: Code Enforcement report was suspended.

Mayor Moore presented the Healthy at Work Plan and included in packet for Council's information.

City Clerk Batliner:

Clerk Batliner presented the financial reports for February, March, April and May. A motion was made by Councilwoman Manning and second by Councilwoman Wood to approve the financial reports as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Clerk Batliner informed the Council that the City has received a refund from Traveler's insurance in the amount of \$14,000 for reimbursement for the overcharge for the Worker's Compensation fine for \$25,000.00 due to not completing the 2018 Worker's Compensation Audit.

Attorney Mark Hall read Resolution 2020-004 Cares Act to recoup loss due to the covid-19 pandemic. A motion was made by Councilwoman Stewart and second by Councilwoman Wilson to approve the resolution as read. Motion carried unanimously.

Attorney Mark Hall read presented Resolution 2020-002 authorizing the participation in the Kentucky League of Cities Investment Pool. A motion was made by Councilwoman Wood and second by Councilwoman Stewart to approve the resolution as read. Motion carried unanimously.

Attorney Mark Hall read Resolution 2020-003 authorizing the Mayor to execute the interlocal agreement and all related documentation as read. A motion was made by Councilman Campbell and second by Councilwoman Manning. Motion carried unanimously.

Clerk Batliner presented information from DATA Max Corporation for collection of lost revenue. A motion was made by Councilwoman Wood and second by Councilwoman Wilson to authorize the Mayor to sign contract and all documentation with Data Max Corporation for collection of past due accounts. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilwoman Wood introduced Ordinance 283-2020 Amending 19-20 Budget. City Attorney Mark Hall gave first reading to Ordinance 283-2020.

Councilwoman Wood introduced Ordinance 284-2020 Budget for FY 20-21. City Attorney Mark hall gave first reading to Ordinance 284-2020.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Wood and second by Councilwoman Manning to adjourn the meeting at 7:47 PM. Motion carried unanimously.
