Present: Mayor Moore, Attorney Hodge, Councilwoman Cook, Councilman Bierbaum, Councilman Embry, Councilwoman Blanton, Councilwoman Wood, Councilwoman Holt, Councilwoman Stewart, and City Clerk Brown.

City Clerk Brown confirmed that we had a quorum.

Mayor Moore called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

Minutes:

A motion was made by Councilman Embry and second by Councilwoman Cook to approve the regular meeting minutes of July 9, 2026. Motion carried unanimously.

Department Reports:

Police:

Assistant Chief Hibbs provided the police department report in the council packet. Assistant Chief Hibbs spoke about a couple thieves who are stealing at Walmart, Target and Lowes on separate occasions, and the officers have been watching so they can apprehend them. Assistant Chief Hibbs spoke on a couple more issues they see within the city.

Mayor Moore stated that the city is very blessed to have a police department and professional police officers who pride themselves in their years of service.

Councilwoman Stewart noted that the reason the city has a very successful police department is because Mayor Moore has spent her efforts to hire the best officers and Councilwoman Stewart thanked Mayor Moore.

Financials:

A motion was made by Councilwoman Stewart to approve the June financial reports and second by Councilwoman Blanton. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor's Report:

Ordinances:

Councilwoman Wood made a motion for Attorney Hodge to read the first summary reading for Ordinance #323 Series 2026 Pertaining to the Amending Various Sections of Chapter 113. Councilwoman Stewart second the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Attorney Hodge stated that, to complete the second reading of the preceding ordinance, we need to schedule a special meeting. Attorney Hodge suggested Tuesday, August 18th at 6:30 PM. Councilwoman Blanton made a motion to hold a special meeting on Tuesday, August 18, 2026, at 6:30 PM. Councilwoman Cook second the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Moore stated that the city is partnering with Precision Concrete to make some necessary repairs to our sidewalks. Mayor Moore handed out a few pictures of the sidewalks that are to be repaired.

Committee's Report:

Councilwoman Cook noted that the Multipurpose Center did not have a meeting in July. Ms. Bierbaum stated that they will have a 40-yard dumpster dropped off at the Multipurpose Center for the week. Ms. Bierbaum stated that it's possible they will have another dumpster in the fall. Councilwoman Cook noted that the Multipurpose Center will stay open until 7:00 PM since school has started. Councilwoman Cook mentioned that the Center has new registration forms for new families who want their children to attend the Center.
