Police:

Assistant Chief Hibbs stated that we have posted a flyer to recruit new police officers, and it will take time.

Financials:

Mayor's Report:

Mayor Moore noted that we got the fence installed behind the police department. Mayor Moore stated that Assistant Clerk Webster is working on applying for a \$50,000.00 playground grant so we can upgrade our playground, but we will need letters of support from the council members. Mayor Moore mentioned that Mr. Webster is working on grants for police vest and body cams. Councilwoman Cook asked about when West Buechel will be getting the LED streetlights. Mayor Moore stated that we have signed the contract with LG & E and are waiting for LG & E to install the lights. Councilwoman Cook asked for an update on the 501 3 (C). Attorney Hodge explained that we applied for a lower allowance of funds which should help speed up the process for the 501 3 (C).
