Department Reports:

Police:

Mayor's Report:

Councilwoman Wood stated that she had been receiving calls about the work on Ulery Avenue and about the road caving in by a drain. Assistant Chief Hibbs noted he would investigate it.

Committee's Report:

Councilwoman Cook noted that the Multipurpose Center did not have a meeting Ms. Bierbaum mentioned it was due to the lunch program and paperwork issues. Ms. Bierbaum stated that they have been taking the kids to the movies, zoo, splashpads, parks and bowling about every two weeks.
