City Council Minutes
Regular City Meeting

February 12, 2019 at 6:00 PM

Mayor Moore called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

There were no minutes from previous council meeting to approve due to the previous city clerk not providing the recorder or information from the previous Council meeting.

Councilman John Campbell and Councilwoman Bonnie Manning sponsored Ordinance #275 Series 2019 to amend the West Buechel City Council Meeting time to the second Thursday of the month at 7:00 pm.

Community Development Director Liz Bierbaum made a request to the council to review information and estimates for the Reach Alert System.

Councilwoman Bonnie Manning resigned from the Ethics Board. Linda Gauthier was appointed to the Ethics Board to fill the vacancy of Bonnie Manning.

Mayor Moore reported that there are a lot of changes that are being made. Mayor Moore is updating accounts, working on the past and present audits with the CPA and working on a budget for FY 19-20. She also informed the Council that the new City Attorney, David Clement, has been hired as a part-time employee.

Residents made complaints regarding the drainage issue on Ethel Avenue. Mayor Moore informed the residents that the city had paid their portion of the funds to fix the issue and MSD had a conflict with the railroad. Mayor Moore told the residents that if there were no current complaints to MSD that the project would be placed on hold. Mayor Moore requested that the residents contact MSD to voice concerns and to make complaints.

A motion to adjourn was made by Councilman John Campbell at 6:44 pm and second by Councilwoman Bonnie Manning. Vote unanimous.
